

BY-LAW NO. 74-05

OF THE

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

Being a by-law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to provide for the provision of fees and charges for services or activities provided by the Corporation of the City of Cambridge and to repeal By-law 57-04.

WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O.2001, c.25, Section 391(1)(2), a municipality and a local board may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons;

- (a) for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it;
- (b) for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or local board; and
- (c) for the use of its property including property under its control.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, Section 392 provides that a municipality and a local board shall establish and maintain a list for public inspection indicating which of its services and activities and the use of which properties will be subject to fees or charges under the Act and the amount of each fee or charge.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge has provided notice of its intention to impose fees and charges for services or activities provided by the Corporation of the City of Cambridge.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge has established various fees and charges in connection with services or activities provided by the Corporation of the City of Cambridge.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Definitions

In this by-law:

“city” means the Corporation of the City of Cambridge.

“person” in this by-law includes a municipality and a local board and the Crown.

1. That the fees and charges for services or activities provided by the City and the use of which properties are subject to fees or charges are attached to this by-law as Schedule “A”
2. That any discounts and other benefits for early payment of the fees and charges are contained in Schedule “A”.
3. That all fees and charges for services and activities are payable upon receipt of the service or upon registration for the activity.
4. That interest charges and other penalties may apply to fees and charges for services and activities that are due and unpaid.

5. That fees and charges for services and activities imposed by the City on a person under this by-law constitute a debt of the person to the City.
6. That By-law 57-04 is hereby repealed.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME.
